WHAT IS EPIC?

The EPIC program gives extra support to families who need help with substance abuse. The goal of EPIC is to get families back together.

There are 4 parts of the EPIC program:

Family
Treatment Drug
Court (FTDC):

Medication for Opioid Use Disorder (MOUD):

FAMILY TREATMENT DRUG COURT



- FTDC is a program that partners the courts, child welfare caseworkers, and substance abuse treatment providers
- This team works together to help parents with substance use disorders get treatment
- EPIC families in FTDC get incentives for participating

MEDICATION FOR OPIOID USE DISORDER

- MOUD (previously known as MAT) is the best treatment for someone with an Opioid Use Disorder
- People on MOUD can go back to their daily lives
- EPIC families in FTDC are prioritized for MOUD





PEER RECOVERY SUPPORTS

- Peer Recovery
 Supporters (PRS)
 are people who are
 in stable recovery
 and have
 experience in the
 Child Welfare
 System
- Your PRS will meet with you weekly (or as much as you need) and support and walk you through recovery





RELATIONAL SKILL BUILDING



- Relational Skill Building for Families is a 16-week home-based program for parents and caregivers to help improve family relationships
- Through EPIC, you get extra support and learn how to deal with conflict, communicate better, and understand your child's needs
