You will create a file folder (that will be posted publicly) that incorporates the questions below. No more than two students may research the same career (first come, first choice). Their information should not be identical.

| 1. | The cover of your file folder should explain the Interior Design/Housing career field you chose & <u>why</u> you chose it. Be colorful, neat and creative (using the Principles & Elements of Design) and reflects the career that you researched. |
| 2. | What is the typical level of education needed for this career, and if there are varying education levels, explain the differences. Find one local (in Ohio) educational option for this career. |
| 3. | List the starting Income for this career, and at least one of the following: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• What is the average income?• What is the maximum income?• Explain the differences in the income levels. |
| 4. | Describe the typical day for a person in this career, including how many hours worked on a typical day, and at least four of the tasks performed on a regular basis. |
| 5. | Describe at least four necessary traits or skills for a person in this career and why these skills are essential. |
| 6. | Include at least two additional interesting facts about this career and at least one famous person in this specific field and include at least one image of their work. |
| 7. | Have at least 3 appropriate sources for this research (not "google" or "wikipedia") and list them on the bottom of the rubric. |
| 8. | Be sure your work is colorful and creative, and somehow represents the kind of career you have researched (example, a designer of a preschool would have a lot of primary colors, and preschool type of images). Include graphics and images, either hand drawn, or printed out. |
