### SUCCESS STORIES ON THE PATH TO EXCEEDING \$30 MILLION

- June 29 saw the ground breaking for the **Kunz-Brundige Franklin County Extension Building** at Waterman Lab (above). All of Central Ohio will benefit from the generosity of **Pat Brundige**, whose \$11 million in gifts during the past two years enables construction of the building and leaves a legacy for endowed educator and support funds for Franklin County Extension and 4-H.
- The impact of a \$284,000 gift from **Bob Evans Farms** will be evident in its myriad uses. The donation over four years will support the Waterman Multi-Species Facility Fund, 4-H Celebration of Youth, 4-H Bob Evans Farms Scholarships, the Meat Judging Team, and The Bob Evans Farms Animal Welfare Scholarship.
- For the second straight year, Ohio 4-H received \$20,000 for winning the national **Raise Your Hand** competition, where states competed for collecting the most hands raised in support of 4-H youth. Nearly 18,000 Ohioans raised their hands this year.
- Construction has begun on the **Secrest Welcome Center** on the Wooster campus now that fundraising has completed. We look forward to the building's dedication this fall.
- The **Centennial Fund for The Department of Agricultural Communication, Education, and Leadership** commemorates ACEL's 100<sup>th</sup> anniversary. This endowment fund will benefit all ACEL students and support faculty.
- The **Knipp Scholarship Fund** will award renewable scholarships to Ohio Agricultural Technical Institute students who plan to transfer to the Columbus campus to finish their four-year degrees. The fund was created through a gift from **Daryl Knipp and Cate Knipp**.
