

## Guidelines and Application for the Jerry Krebs Honorary Scholarship Due: July 8

In an effort to honor the volunteerism of Jerry Krebs and to recognize the youth of Clermont County, the Clermont County 4-H Advisory Committee has put forth the Jerry Krebs Honorary Scholarship. The purpose of this scholarship is to financially assist high school Seniors, and/or first year graduates who are continuing their education at an accredited institution in any field. This scholarship is open to Clermont County 4-H members who must complete a minimum of one project during the year of application. This is a nonrenewable scholarship awarded in the amount of \$500.

### Guidelines

- The applicant must be a high school senior, or a graduate continuing their education at an accredited institution.
- They must have been both eligible to be a participant in 4-H (not older than 18 years of age as of January 1, of the current year) and must have served as an active participant in the Clermont County 4-H during that year.
- Applicants must have participated in Clermont County 4-H for a minimum of 4 years.
- Completed 4-H Achievement Record
- All questions on the application form along with other supplemental materials must be answered to be considered for an award.
- High school and/or college transcripts must be attached. Unofficial transcripts are acceptable but must be signed by a high school counselor.

Applications will be judged on the following basis: Scholastic Standing 20%  
Citizenship and Leadership 20%  
Essays 30%  
4-H Participation/Achievement Record 30%

**The scholarship recipient will be announced and must be present at Skillathon Awards. It will be awarded after the successful completion (GPA 2.5 or higher) of the first grading period which should be sent (emailed) to the OSU Extension Office.**
