Proposals Due by Midnight, Sunday, November 20, 2022

The EHE Research Forum highlights the research efforts of our faculty, postdocs, research scientists and graduate and undergraduate students; proposals from all these groups are welcome!

Three presentation types are accepted:

1. Oral Presentations: Presentations by any individual or up to three researchers together.
2. Panel Discussion: Presenters include groups of up to four researchers.
3. Posters: Traditional poster presentations will be for students only

Proposal Submission Format and Content

1. *Title*: The project title should be no more than 20 words long (shorter is better).
2. *Conference Booklet Description*: 350 characters maximum (approximately 50 words).
3. *Presentation Type*: Oral Presentation, Panel Discussion, Individual Poster Presentation
4. *Application*: Create a single document with the required proposal details as listed in the table above. You will be asked to cut and paste the file into a text only box. Keep formatting to a bare minimum. 900 word limit – approximately 3 pages.

Proposal Review All proposals will be peer-reviewed based on the following criteria: clarity of research topic/critical issue, objectives/research questions, findings/outcomes, and broader impacts. **Proposals that describe completed research and/or address equity, inclusion and diverse perspectives are highly encouraged.**
