## Adult participants needed

### About

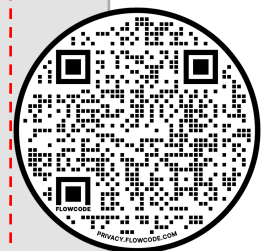
We want to better understand how people interact and communicate with people who have similar or different neurotypes (i.e., autistic, non-autistic). In this study, participants will be asked EITHER to describe an image for another participant to draw or to listen to another participant's instructions to draw an image.

### Eligibility

You are eligible to participate in this study if you are 18 years or older. You may be non-autistic OR you may be a person who identifies as autistic, a person with autism, or on the spectrum (formal diagnosis or self-identification accepted).

### What's Involved

- You will meet virtually with a researcher and another participant for approximately 30 minutes (you will need access to Internet, Zoom, a camera, and a microphone).
- You will need access to physical or digital drawing materials, including four different colors of a writing utensil of your choice.
- You will complete two brief surveys: one about your experience in the task and one about characteristics of yourself.
- You must be comfortable speaking and understanding English.
- You will receive \$10 for participating in the study.
