






## ROTTWEILER

This working breed originated in Europe. Coat is medium in length, dense, and straight. Color is black with rust to mahogany markings. Breed is of medium size (22 to 27 inches high at the withers) with a compact build and docked tail. They are robust and powerful. Temperament is calm, confident, and courageous. They are used for companions, guardians, and police work.


## BEAGEL

This hound breed originated in England. Coat is close and hard. Colors are multiples of black, white, brown, and orange. Breed has a solid build and is bred for two sizes: less than 13 inches high and 13 to 15 inches high at the withers. Temperament is cheerful and obedient. They are bred to hunt cottontail rabbits.


## GOLDEN RETRIEVER

This sporting breed originated in Great Britain. Coat is dense and water repellent with moderate feathering. Color is Rich, lustrous gold of various shades. Breed has a rugged build and is of medium size (21.5 to 24 inches high at the withers). Temperament is gentle and eager. They are preferred for hunting waterfowl.




## BOXER

This working breed originated in Europe. Coat is flat, short, and shiny. Color is fawn or brindle. Breed has a square build and is of medium size (21 to 25 inches high at the withers) with docked tail. Temperament is alert, courageous, and playful, yet wary of strangers. They were originally used for fighting, but are now used as police dogs, guard dogs, and dog guides for the blind.



## BULLDOG

This non-sporting breed originated in Great Britain. Coat is straight, smooth, short, and flat. Head, neck, and shoulders are covered with wrinkles and dewlap. Color is red brindle, other brindles, solid white, red, fawn, or fallow, or piebald. Breed is of medium size (40 to 50 pounds) with a heavy, thick, and low-swung body. Temperament is kind, courageous, and dignified.




## MINIATURE SCHNAUZERS

This terrier breed originated in Germany. Outercoat is hard and wiry; undercoat is close. Color is salt and pepper, black and silver, or solid black. Breed has a robust and sturdy build (12 to 14 inches high at the withers). Temperament is alert, spirited, and obedient. Devoted to their families, they serve well as guard dogs.



## GERMAN SHEPARD

This herding breed originated in Germany. Outercoat is straight, harsh of medium length, and lies close to the body. Color is black/tan, sable, or all black. Breed is of medium size (22 to 26 inches high at the withers) and well-muscled. Temperament is loyal and fearless. They are easily trained and commonly used for police work and dog guides for the blind.




## YORKSHIRE TERRIERS

This toy breed originated in England. Coat is glossy, fine, silky, straight, and moderately long. Color is dark steel-blue with a tan head. Breed has a neat, compact build, and its weight should not exceed 7 pounds. They have a very confident, spirited manner and are used for pleasure and companionship.



# WEST HIGHLAND WHITE TERRIER

This terrier breed originated in Scotland. Coat is double-coated, medium in length, hard and straight. Color is white. Breed is small (10 to 12 inches high at the withers) with a strong build. Temperament is alert, friendly, and courageous. These dogs are bred for hunting.



# DACHSHUND

This hound breed originated in Germany. Coat can be smooth, long-haired, or wirehaired. Solid-color dogs are primarily red, and the two-color dogs are black, chocolate, wild boar, gray, or fawn with tan markings. They can also have a dappled or brindle pattern. Breed has a muscular build with long bodies and short legs. Miniatures are 11 pounds and under, while standards are 16 to 32 pounds. Temperament is clever and courageous. They are bred to hunt badgers and burrow underground in pursuit.




# **SHETLAND SHEEPDOG**

This herding breed originated in the Shetland Islands of Scotland. Outercoat is long, straight, and harsh, while undercoat is short, fury and very dense. Color is black, blue merle, or sable with carrying amounts of white and/or tan markings. Breed is small (13 to 16 inches high at the withers), agile and sturdy. Temperament is extremely loyal, affectionate, and somewhat reserved with strangers. They are bred for herding sheep and are good watchdogs.




# **SHIH TZU**

This toy breed originated in the Orient. Coat is luxurious, dense, long, flowing, and double-coated. Color will vary. This small breed ideally measures 9 to 10  $\frac{1}{2}$  inches at the withers. These dogs were bred as palace pets. Today they still have a proud bearing and are outgoing, happy, and affectionate companions and house pets.



# POODLE


This non-sporting breed presumably originated in Germany or France. Coat is profuse, harsh, and composed of thick, close curls. Solid colors include blue, gray, silver, brown, café-au-lait, apricot or cream. Breed is well proportioned, squarely built and divided into three size categories: Standard – over 15 inches at the withers; Miniature – 10 to 15 inches high at the withers; and Toy – 10 inches high or under at the withers. Temperament is very active, intelligent, and proud. Breed was originally bred as water retrievers – “duck dogs.”



# LABRADOR RETRIEVER

This sporting breed originated in Newfoundland. Coat is short, dense, and water repellent. Color is black, yellow, or chocolate. Breed is of medium size (21.5 to 24.5 inches high at the withers) with a strong build. Although widely used to retrieve game, their gentle temperament makes them good pets. They are also a popular breed as dog guides for the blind.






## Safety/Sanitation -

Exhibitors will be asked to evaluate the picture and identify problems within the picture. They should be able to state how to fix these problems.

- Barbecue grill should be covered. Do not leave a hot grill with exposed food unattended.
- No toxic plants in yard
- Secure lock on gate
- Sturdy fencing
- Wire mesh under gate if there is space for dog to get out
- Sand pit or tall grassy area in which to train dog to eliminate
- All chemicals are stored away from dog area
- Fencing to keep dog out of garden
- Covered and locked trash cans or closed trash bin
- Secured plan containers that cannot be knocked over
- Any type of garden pond covered with wire mesh
- Fresh drinking water accessible at all times


## **GROOMING MITT**

Used to lift out dirt, dust, and dead hair from either short-or long-haired dogs, these flexible fingertips are great for grooming around legs, tail, and hard to reach places.




## **ELIZABETHAN COLLAR**

This is used to keep a dog from removing bandages or sutures, or to prevent self-injury.



## CLIPPERS

Used to clip the coats of dogs, these come in different styles, usually with detachable blades and snap on combs.




## COMBINATION BRUSH

This general maintenance brush has pins that reach deep into the undercoat and bristles that smooth and detangle the undercoat.



## **STRAIGHT SHEARS**

Use these carefully when trimming your pet's hair. The ends are sharp and could injure you or your dog.




## **BASKET MUZZLE**

This provides protection from aggressive, injured or fear-biting dogs. It safely allows the dog to slightly open its jaw, decreasing the chances of accidental choking.




## **SLICKER BRUSH**


This oblong-shaped brush with a handle has a dense setting of fine wire bristles that are helpful in removing loose hair, tangles, and debris from the coat.



## **THINNING SHEARS**

These shears are used to thin and blend the dog's coat, as well as to shape and finish the legs and lower part of the chest on certain breeds.






## GROOMING TABLE WITH ARM

This is the ideal piece of equipment for grooming your dog. Fasten a grooming noose to the arm to secure the dog.

## NAIL TRIMMERS



This grooming tool features a "safety stop" nail protector, plus safety lock. The nonslip handles give you extra control while trimming your dog's nails.
