

Checklist for the Fulton County Fair:

- Complete your [DUNF FORM](http://www.go.osu.edu/fultondunf) (www.go.osu.edu/fultondunf)! – Required for ALL market animals, lactating dairy cows and lactating dairy goats!
- Review the Arrival & Check-in times (NOTE THE UPDATED SCALE LOCATIONS for HOGS/SHEEP/GOATS)
 - Scales will be open 12pm-8pm on Thursday, August 31, 2023
 - **Hogs** will be in the hog barn
 - **Sheep** will be in the end of the old goat barn. Where the joint scale for goats and sheep were in the past.
 - **Goats** will be in the Spangler Arena in the Southeast corner.
- What should I bring?
 - Feed/Water Bedding
 - All species must provide their own bedding. No exceptions.
 - Water bucket
 - Feed bucket/bowl
 - Feed/Hay
 - Manure Shovel/rake + muck tub
 - Fan + Fan hanger
 - Halter + lead rope (having a spare never hurts)
 - Water if you have a picky drinker! Some animals do not prefer city water & do best if they have access to water similar to what they drink at home.
 - Grooming/Fitting
 - Show box/Tack box – please note, you ARE NOT guaranteed space for your Show Box
 - Hose
 - hose nozzle
 - wash bucket
 - Scrub brush / sponge
 - soap
 - clippers
 - any other important grooming tools
 - Other
 - Chairs
 - Staple gun
 - Show clothing (review the Fulton Co. Handbook if you have questions about the appropriate attire)
 - Show halter/lead
 - clean boots
 - chute/stand
