

An Analysis of Property Taxes and Housing Costs in Cook County, Illinois

Methodology

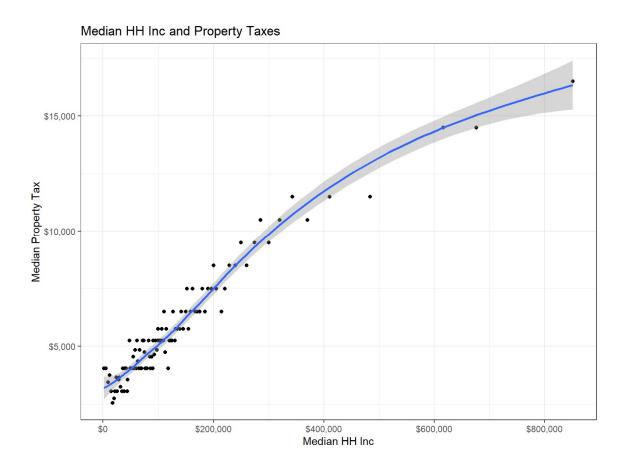
Data used in this report is gathered from the United States Census Bureau public use microdata sample (PUMS). PUMS variables are either released by household or by person. These tables are reported on the PUMA (public use microdata area) geography. There are 36 PUMAs in Cook County. The PUMS variable on property taxes paid (TAXAMT) is available only for owner occupied households and all maps/figures are limited to owner occupied households only.

The following 2022 PUMS (public use microdata sample) 1-Year tables are used in this section:

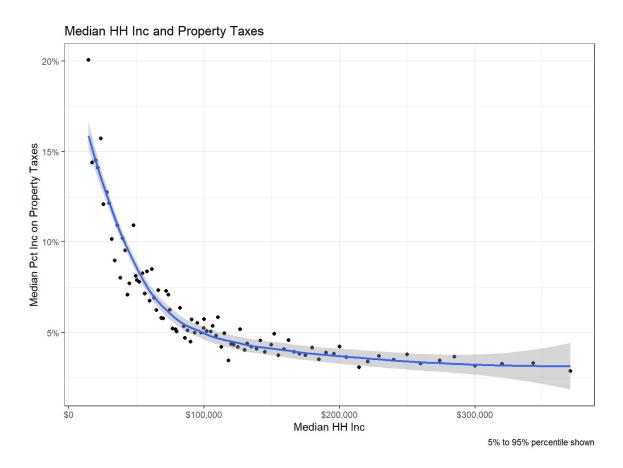
- HINCP: Household income (past 12 months, use ADJINC to adjust HINCP to constant dollars)
- HHLDRAGEP: Age of the householder
- TAXAMT: Property taxes (yearly real estate taxes)
- HHLDRHISP: Recoded detailed Hispanic origin of the householder
- HHLDRRAC1P: Recoded detailed race code of the householder

The following additional variables are also utilized in calculations:

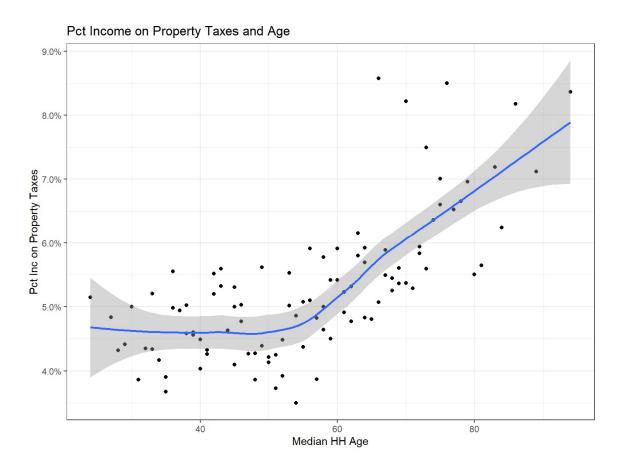
- SERIALNO: Housing unit/GQ person serial number
- PUMA: Public use microdata area code (PUMA) based on 2020 Census definition (areas with population of 100,000 or more, use with ST for unique code)
- ST: State Code based on 2020 Census definitions
- SPORDER: Person number
- WGPT: Housing Unit Weight
- PWGTP: Person's weight



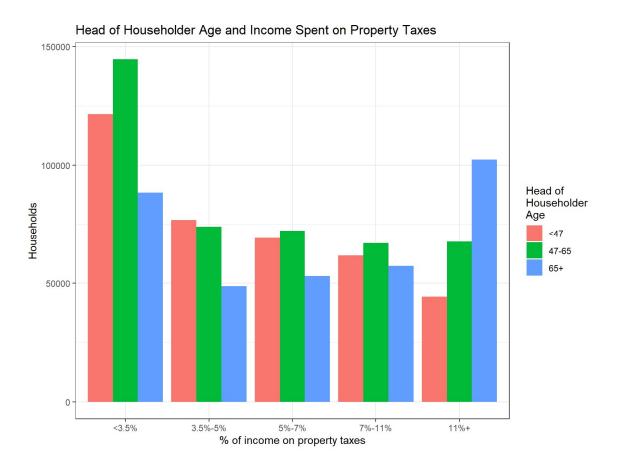
Households with greater incomes generally pay more in property taxes. The median owner occupied household has a household income of about \$100,000 and tax amount of about \$5000.



Generally, households above the median income (\$100,000) pay less than 5% of their income on property taxes and those below the median pay more than 5% in property taxes.



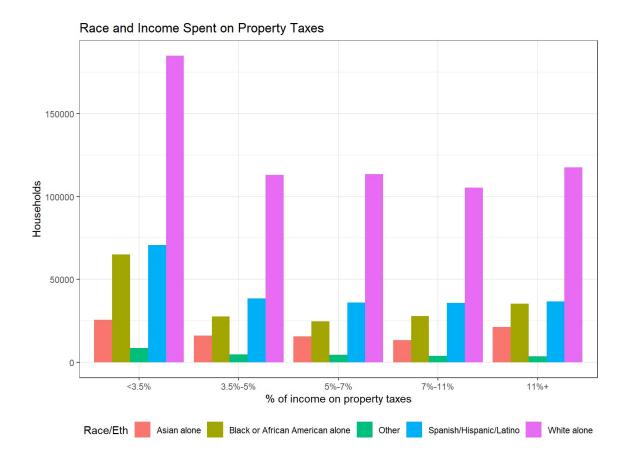
Households with the head of household at our below the median age (55) generally pay around 5% of their income on property taxes. Senior and older households pay a greater share of their income on property taxes.



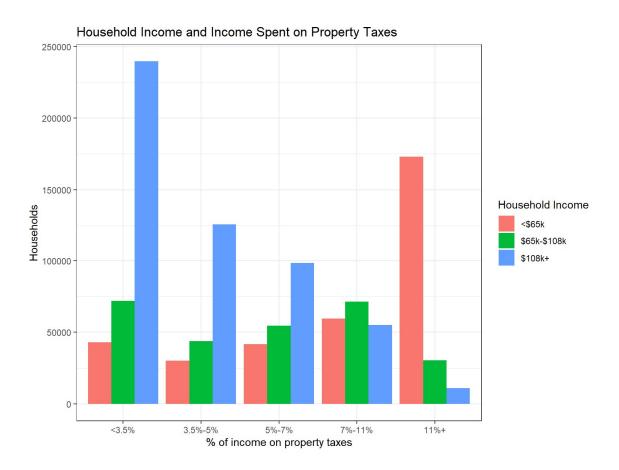
Among households with a share of 11% or more of income spent on property taxes, 48% of such households have a head of householder age of 65+.



These figures show age and race/ethnicity for % of income spent on property taxes. Generally, age is more relevant than race/ethnicity.



55% of households with an 11%+ share of income on property taxes have a head of householder with race white alone. This proportion is in line with the total share of households in Cook County with white alone head of household (55%).



This is another way to show that lower income households pay a greater share of their income in property taxes and higher income households pay a lower share.

Table shows total number of owner occupied households and counts with above 10% and 20% of income and total number of senior (65+) households and counts with above 10% and 20% of income.

- B25088: Median Selected Monthly Owner Costs (Dollars) by Mortgage Status
- B25092: Median Selected Monthly Owner Costs as a Percentage of Household Income

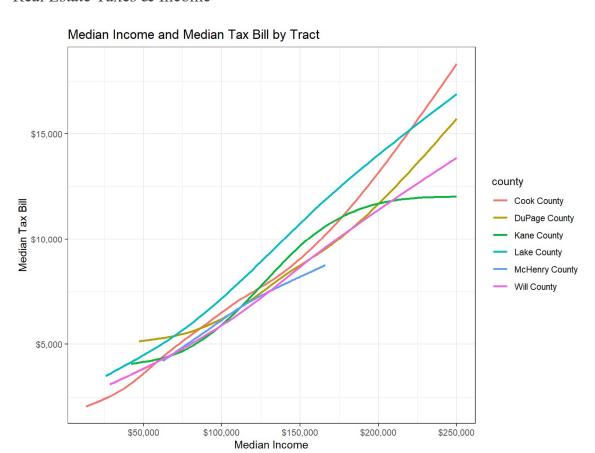
The ACS releases information on "selected monthly owner costs" (SOC). These costs include ongoing monthly costs of homeownership including real estate taxes, insurance, utilities, condominium fees, and mortgage/debt payments. Methodologically, it is possible to exclude mortgage payments from SOC but it is included presently.

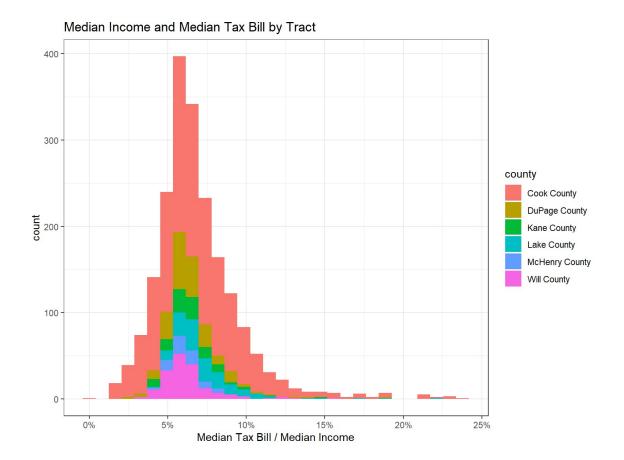

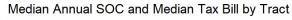

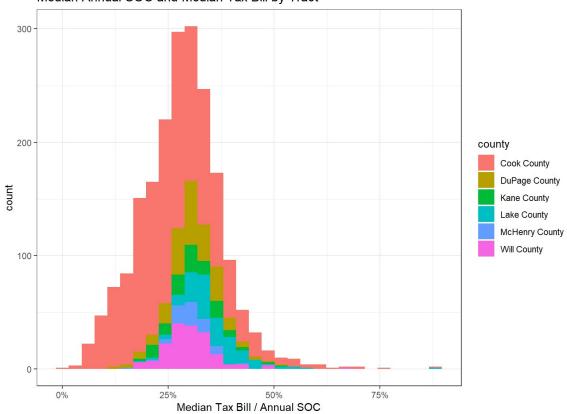

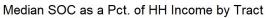


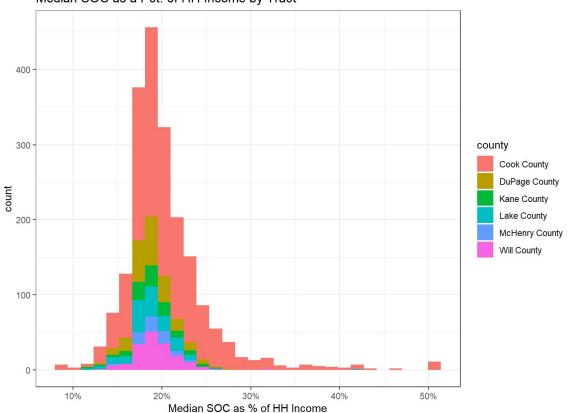
