Elevating the Art of Idea Exchange



- Schedule a new meeting in 2020 for arrival by March 31, 2021, and no attrition or cancellation fees will apply until 60 days in advance of arrival.
- This special provision applies to contracted meeting rooms and food and beverage revenue.

We understand this and aim to deliver a clear value and return on investment for every prospective convening organized at the Forum.
