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When to use Panopto and Zoom?

Panopto

- Intended Use:
 - Storage
 - Create videos
 - Asynchronous engagement
- Video quality: High
- Student video submission: Yes
- Example Use:
 - Pre-recorded mini lectures
 - Students record themselves
 - Share other videos

<u>Zoom</u>

- Intended Use:
 - Synchronous meeting
 - Record said meeting
- Video quality: Low
- Student video submission: No
- Example Use:
 - Record a Zoom class meeting
 - Students record a dialogue with fellow students

Effective Practices for Instructional Videos

- Plan in advance (script/outline)
- Keep your videos short (8-12 min)
 - a. One clear learning objective
- Use a conversational tone
 - a. Convey tone through inflection and gesture
- Show slides *and* yourself on camera
 - a. Illustrate abstract concepts with motion, colors, and/or shapes
- Signpost key information
- Use active learning strategies (e.g. in-video quiz)
- Caption your videos (see section IV today)

Goal: Share content with students

 If you want to share videos from YouTube or elsewhere on the web that has a "Share" feature, you can simply embed them on Canvas' Rich Content Area, unless you want to make use of Panopto's engagement features.
