Identifying vs Reading Objects

Identifying Objects

- emphasizes *naming* to identify objects
- Then time to teach the child to name something else

Reading Objects

- different aspects of an object convey meaning
- requires detailed
 observations and emphasizes
 critical thinking



Benefits of Object Based Learning

Objects offer authentic experiences that provide:

- Language differentiation
- Reading level differentiation
- Knowledge level differentiation
- Learning style differentiation
- Age differentiation
