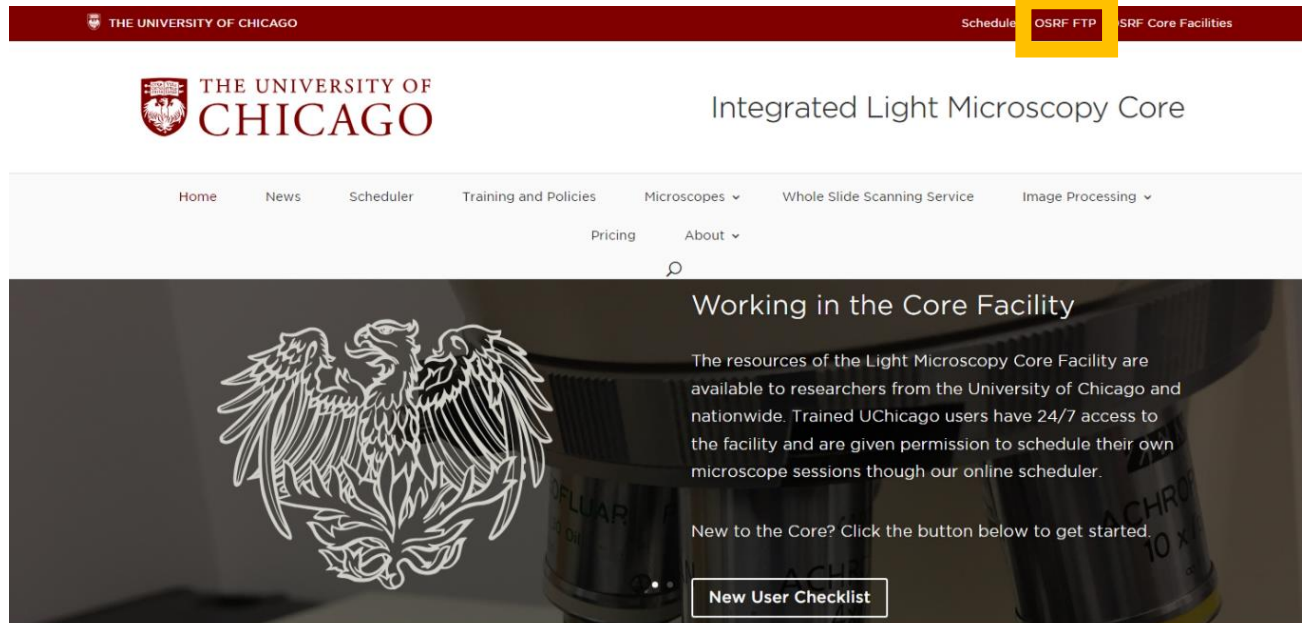


# To Access Your Data:

Welcome to Integrated Light Microscopy

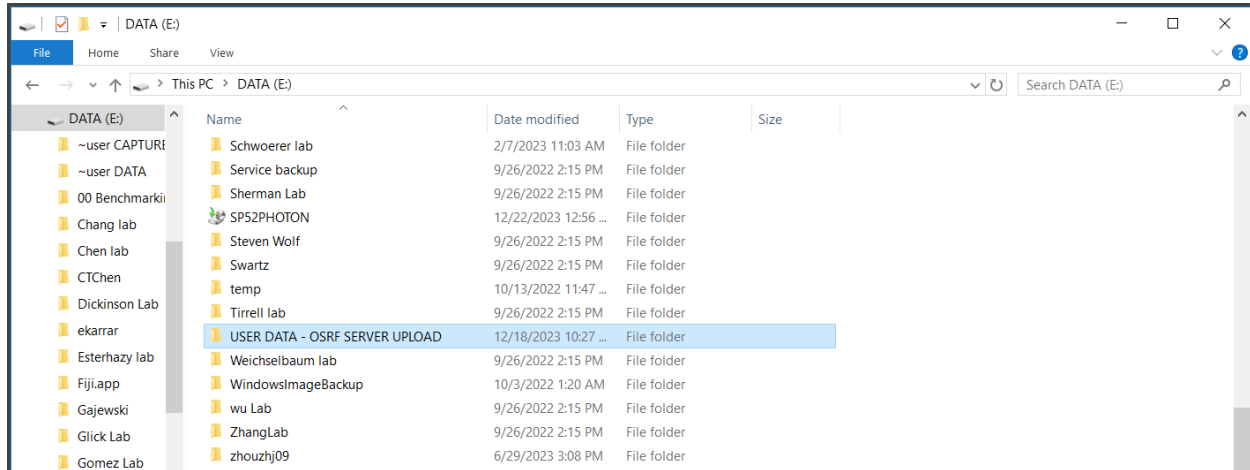
Then enter your lab id and password (see below).

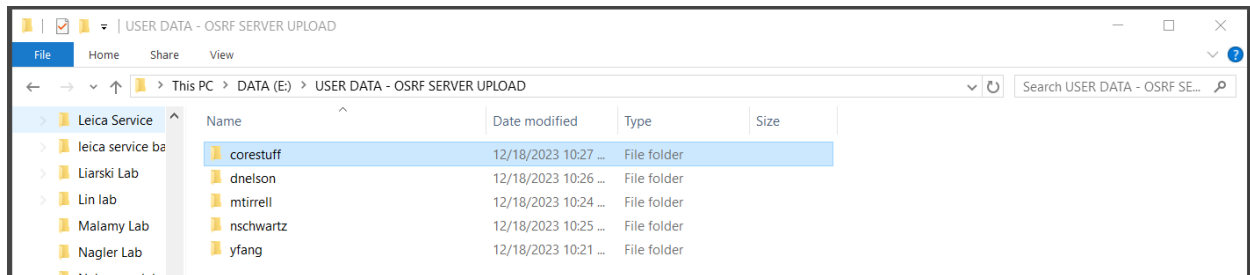

# To Save Your Data:

Users will no longer need to create a server account or map into the server. Instead, users will save directly to the temporary storage folder on each computer's local hard drive. To save on the local hard-drive, locate the file labeled "USER DATA – OSRF SERVER UPLOAD".



Locate the file with the first initial of your PI's first name and your PI's last name,



then locate the folder with your cnet ID.
