### Student Spotlight - Justin Mun



Justin Mun is a second year Crown student. Prior to pursuing his master's degree and joining GPHAP, he worked on political campaigns across the country where he initially specialized in opposition research before pivoting to field organizing. Through his own personal experiences with government programs, such as Medicaid, Justin became more interested in welfare systems and how they impact one's health. Applying his own experience, Justin appreciated the interdisciplinary aspect of GPHAP that created an environment for others to share their perspectives pertaining to health equity.
