Student Spotlight - Alanoud Alsulaiman



Alanoud Alsulaiman is a first year Harris student. She did her undergraduate studies in Saudi Arabia in law. Alanoud primarily practiced administrative, commercial, and contract law, but always had an interest in health. After graduating, she was enrolled at Georgetown LL.M. (Master's of Law) program where she focused on national and global health law. While working on her first master's, Alanoud worked on multiple projects at the [O'Neill Institute for National and Global Health Law](#). The projects ranged from the COVID Law Lab, the HIV Policy Lab, and even a project where she worked on a legal brief for the Department of Justice pertaining to substance withdrawals within jails.

Alanoud felt there was a gap in her knowledge and wanted to understand how to analyze data that she often worked on in her previous legal experience. With GPHAP's diverse and interdisciplinary cohort of students, Alanoud believes she will learn and contribute to her colleagues in a collaborative working environment where she can further focus on her goals of achieving health equity through social determinants of health.
