Downtown Campus Connector Shuttle - Free Shuttle

Starting on Monday, Jan 9 with partial service



and fully operational by Tuesday, January 17, the Department of Safety & Security (DSS) is launching the Downtown Campus Connector shuttle to provide free transportation for UChicago students and employees. The shuttle will run between the Hyde Park campus, the Gleacher Center, downtown UChicago Medicine clinics, the Roosevelt CTA station, and the Metra Electric 51st/53rd Street station. The shuttle will run Monday to Friday from 6:30 AM to 10:00 PM. The shuttle will be free for all members of the campus community with a tap of your UChicago ID!

- o This route will begin partial service on Monday, January 9, with possibly extended wait times between shuttles; the route will be fully operational by Tuesday, January 17.
- o Shuttles will run the route continuously Monday through Friday from 6:30 a.m. to 10 p.m., excluding holidays, with approximately 20 minutes between shuttles.
- o A detailed route map is on the <u>DSS website</u>, and real-time shuttle locations and arrival/departure times are available on the <u>TransLoc</u> app.
