Election Day



Early voting for the Tuesday, Feb 28 municipal election is currently underway [throughout](#) the city. Find a voting location near you at that link. You can **register** to vote even on election day. To register on election day, bring a valid government ID and proof of residence to your polling site. See [FAQs](#) about eligibility to vote and other frequently asked questions. **Please note: any voter in Chicago can vote at any Early Voting site, no matter where they live in the city. Voters can choose whatever voting site is most convenient for them, including on Election Day.** There is a location for voting on election day (Tuesday) on the UChicago campus at the Reynolds Club, 5706 S University Ave.

Not only is the mayoral race underway, but this is your chance to have your voice be heard in regards to other key issues, such as police accountability.
