Consensus Panel on Racial Bias and Healthcare Algorithms: Public Meeting | Agency for Healthcare Research and Quality (AHRQ) and the National Institute on Minority Health and Health Disparities (NIMHD)

Healthcare algorithms can offer value in diagnostics and treatments, but they also can create and perpetuate inequities in healthcare. To address this issue, AHRQ and NIMHD hosted a [2-day meeting](#) in March to present a draft of an AHRQ [Evidence Report](#) examining the published studies on this topic and learn from the field about the state of the science and current perspectives. The March meeting informed the development of a set of guiding principles by a diverse expert panel on preventing or mitigating bias related to healthcare algorithms that affect racial and ethnic disparities in healthcare. Join this webinar to hear a presentation of the draft principles and feedback on the principles.
