

NOMINATIONS FOR MASTERS THESIS READING COMMITTEE

Academic Senate Regulation 17.4 states that: "A Committee to read and evaluate the Master's thesis is appointed by the candidate's program, and the program shall at the same time notify the Division of Graduate Studies of the membership of the Committee by the end of the second week of the quarter in which the degree is to be granted. The majority of the membership of a thesis reading committee shall be members of the Santa Cruz Division of the Academic Senate. A change in the membership of the committee, once appointed, may only be made with the approval of the Graduate Dean."

All programs require three committee members except Computational Media, which has been approved by Graduate Council for two.
