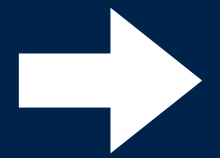

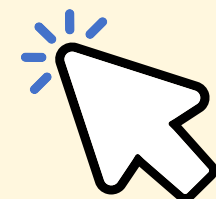

# What is the Research Experience Fellowship?

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The Fall Research Experience Fellowship (REF) is an opportunity for UCI undergraduates engaged in research projects or creative activities, mentored by UCI faculty, to receive recognition and potential funding as a UROP Fellow.

Funding is limited and intended for **reimbursement of project-related expenses** within the 2024-25 academic school year.

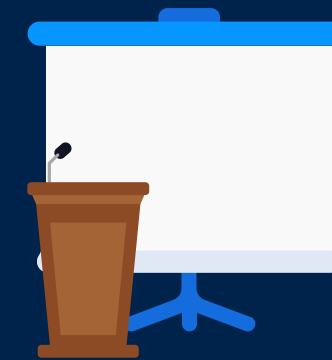

# Eligibility

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- ✓ UCI undergraduate student through at least winter quarter 2025
- ✓ UCI Faculty Mentor guidance
- ✓ Good academic standing (2.0+ GPA)
- ✓ Submit a maximum of 1 individual project for funding and/or any number of group projects or non-funded individual projects
- ✓ Project must have specific aims

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Awardees who are continuing students are required to present their research at the Undergraduate Research Symposium in the spring following receiving their award, but are not automatically registered.

# Prepare Your Application

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## Documents You Need:

- Proposal
- Personal Statement
- Faculty Mentor Agreement Form 

## Note about the application system:

- “Save As Draft” so you can come back to the form at any time
  - Use this!
- “Submit Application” - no further changes are allowed, application is finalized

# What is a Proposal?

A proposal describes your project.

Thesis, Purpose, Objective, & Approach	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Why is this project significant?</li><li>• What are the project’s goals?</li></ul>
Responsibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What is your role?<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◦ For group projects each group member’s responsibilities must be discussed</li></ul></li><li>• How is your work independent from your mentor’s?</li></ul>
Budget	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Itemized budget of expenses</li></ul>
Timeline	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What is your project timeline for the academic year?</li></ul>
References	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What resources will you use?</li></ul>

Students submitting a group project should all contribute to the proposal writing process and choose one student to submit the application.

# Create a Project Timeline

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Describe how you plan to allocate your time on this to successfully answer your research question each week of the project.

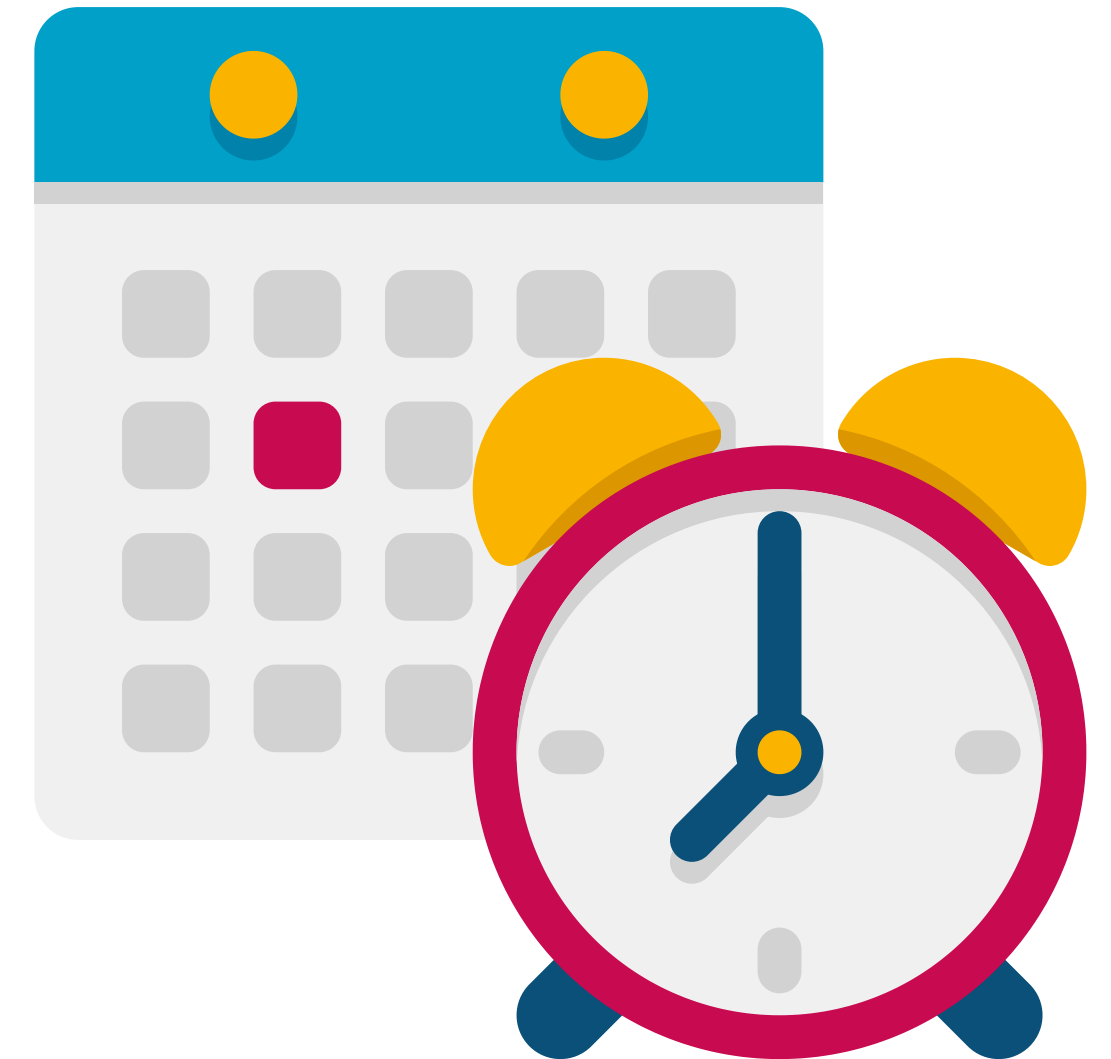

**Create an outline of your specific research process with what needs to be completed**

(i.e. data collection, analysis, trainings, meetings)

2

**List goals to be met during each week to ensure that the project is progressing efficiently**





# Proposal Formatting

Typically 3-5 Pages

- Can be longer or shorter

Please refer to the 2024 REF Application Guide for formatting specifications

- Pages 7-10



Content/organization varies by field of study. Talk to your faculty mentor on how to organize your proposal.

# What is a Personal Statement?

A personal statement describes your relationship to the project.

<b>Motivation for Research</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Why do you want to pursue this research?</li></ul>
<b>Benefits and Goals</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How will pursuing this project help you move toward your academic, career, and/or personal goals?</li></ul>
<b>Research Background</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What is your research background, including what you may have accomplished so far in the field you are researching?</li></ul>
<b>Personal Significance</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Why does this project matter to you?</li></ul>

# Personal Statement Formatting

Typically 1-2 Pages

- Can be longer or shorter

Students submitting group projects should write **individual personal statements** and compile them into a **single document** for application submission.

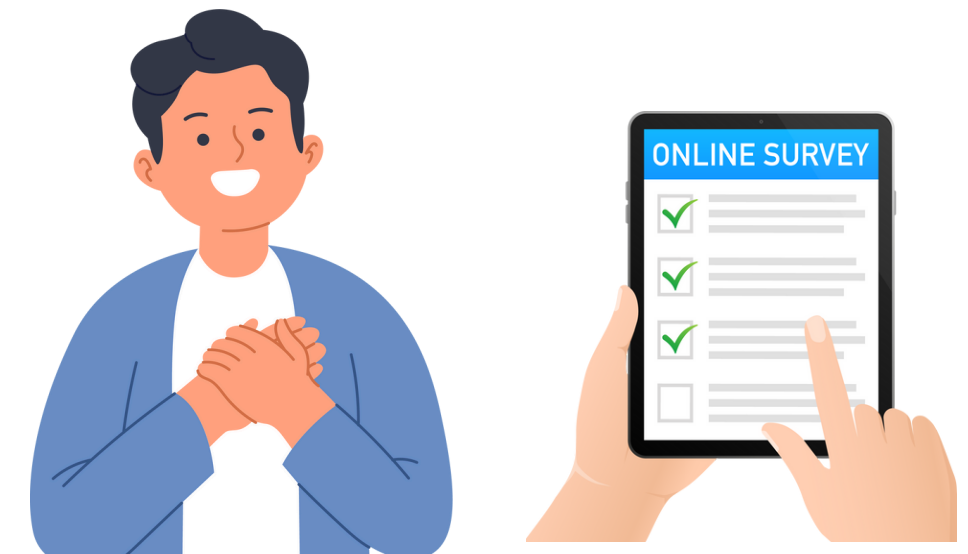
# Conducting Ethical Research

**Students must consult with their Faculty Mentor to determine if Institutional Review Board (IRB) or Institutional Animal Care and Use Committee (IACUC) approval is needed.**

**Human Subject Research  
(IRB)**



**Review UROP's Research Protections Instructions to determine if IRB or IACUC review is required, and if applicable, receive guidance on procedural details.**
