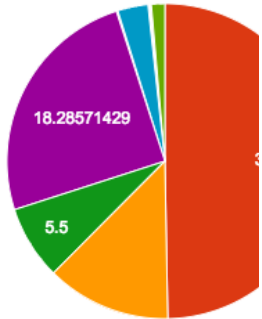

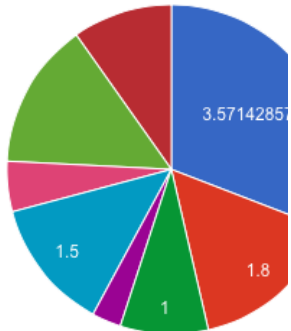

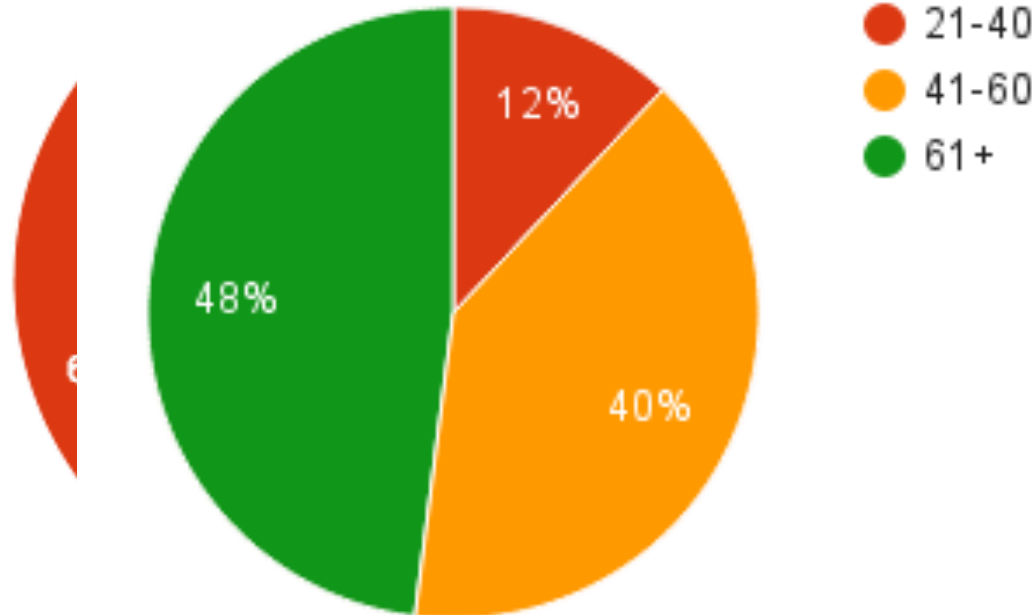
Weighted interest level



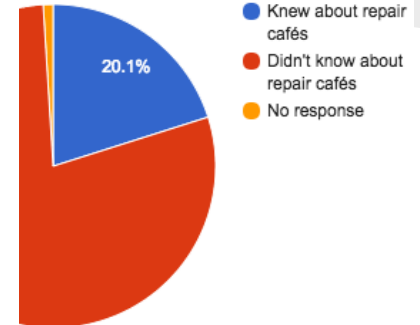
Weighted interest level by



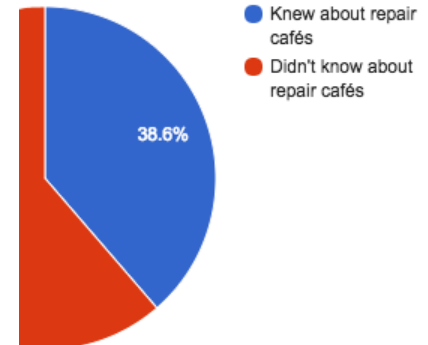
Age Ranges interested in Repair Café: Ledbury

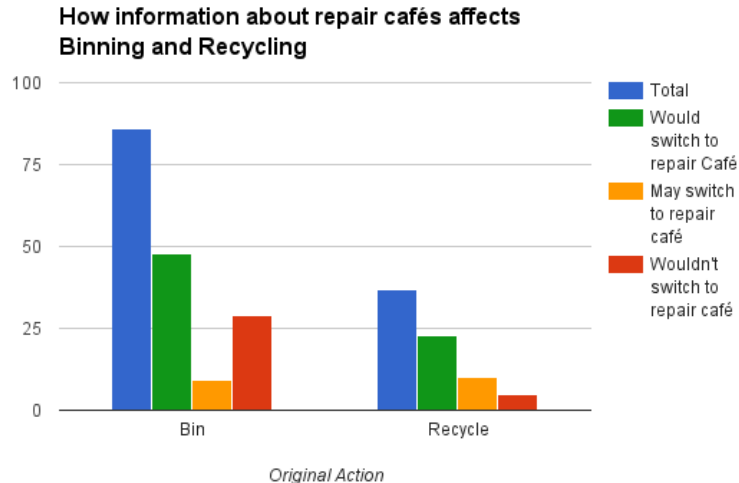
