






Percent of Visitors Through Each Entrance







Dwell Time in Room 33 (in minutes)




Average Dwell Time (in minutes)




Visitors followed the CHRONOLOGICAL Order










Did Visitors take Pictures?






BM Guide Book




Trace Map




Heat Map






Tour Group Heat Map












- 1. Labels/descriptions
