She stated that the goal of Astronomy Club is to expose the student body to astronomical phenomena and astrophotography. They foster a fun, learning-orientated, inclusive environment. Anyone who is interested in astronomy can attend. Their events range from laying down and looking at the stars to building telescopes. Additionally, members of Astronomy Club stargaze, do astrophotography workshops, planetarium visits, and launch/landing parties. The club's most recent challenges include trip scheduling due to unpredictable weather, funding their trips and equipment, and engaging the student body on a remote platform. Some events Astronomy Club has planned are virtual lectures, socially distant stargazing, and cookie decorating over Zoom.
