This past weekend, Fr. Mike spoke after most of the Masses explaining our Capital Campaign, Called to Renew. The main thrust of this Campaign is to refurbish Msgr. Crean Hall, which was built over 40 years ago. Fr. Mike displayed the plans which will add bathrooms and modernize the kitchen facilities and interior space. Msgr. Crean Hall hosts such events as the Pancake Breakfast, Coffee & Donuts, ministry meetings, funeral and baptismal receptions, and school day care and events-to name just a few. A second goal is to refurbish the sound system in the church.

The good news is that 90 parishioners have taken us to more than 64% of our goal. Thank you. We collected a total of \$39,900 at our receptions. There is still time to participate. Thank you for your generosity.

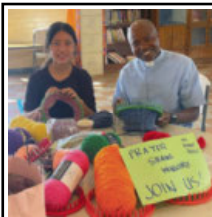

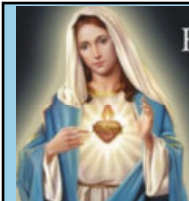

Pentecost

This weekend, the Church celebrates Pentecost, one of the most important feast days of the year that concludes the Easter season and celebrates the beginning of the Church.

Pentecost always occurs 50 days after the death and resurrection of Jesus, and ten days after His ascension into heaven. The name of the day itself is derived from the Greek word "pentecoste," meaning 50th. Because Easter is a moveable feast without a fixed date, and Pentecost depends on the timing of Easter, Pentecost can fall anywhere between May 10 and June 13.

There is a parallel Jewish holiday, Shavu'ot, which falls 50 days after Passover. Shavu'ot commemorates the sealing of the Old Covenant on Mount Sinai, when the Lord revealed the Torah to Moses on Mount Sinai. Every year, the Jewish people renew their acceptance of the gift of the Torah on this feast.

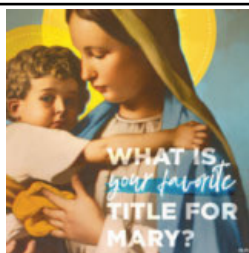
Pentecost is the celebration of the person of the Holy Spirit coming upon the Apostles, Mary, and the first followers of Jesus, who were gathered together in the Upper Room.

A "strong, driving" wind filled the room where they were gathered, and tongues of fire came to rest on their heads, allowing them to speak in different languages so that they could understand each other.

The Holy Spirit also gave the apostles the other gifts and fruits necessary to fulfill the great commission - to go out and preach the Gospel to all nations. It fulfills the New Testament promise from Christ (Luke 24:46-49) that the Apostles would be "clothed with power" before they would be sent out to spread the Gospel. ~CNA

May ~ Mary's Month The Many Titles of Mary

Our Lady Queen of Peace, who is also known as Mother of Peace and Our Lady of Peace, actually has two feast days. The universal Church celebrates her on July 9, she is also commemorated on January 24 and is often represented holding a dove and an olive branch. In 1917, during World War I, Pope Benedict XV asked people to pray to Mary under this title for an end to the devastation that was occurring on battlefields throughout the world.

The Immaculate Heart of Mary, whose feast is celebrated on August 22, is closely related to the Sacred Heart. In honoring Jesus' Sacred Heart, we acknowledge His incredible and boundless love for all people, a love which is often ignored or spurned. The heart of Mary, however, is turned instead toward her Son, and is a sign of her love and devotion to God. St. John Eudes (whose feast day is August 19) is particularly known for his devotion to the Sacred Hearts of both Jesus and Mary.

Our Lady of the Angels comes to us from Costa Rica and began with the discovery of a statue only three inches high. A woman came upon this tiny depiction of Mary along a footpath on the Feast of the Holy Angels, August 2, 1635. She took the image home, but it soon disappeared only to reappear in the place where she originally found it. When the same thing happened five more times, it was determined that Our Lady wanted a shrine built on that spot. In 1935, Pope Pius XI declared the shrine of the Queen of Angels a basilica, and miracles have occurred there ever since. Our Lady Queen of the Angels is the Patroness of our Archdiocese. The Church of Our Lady Queen of the Angels, known as "La Placita" was built in 1814 as the first Church in the City of Los Angeles, which is an abbreviation for the full name "El Pueblo de Nuestra Senora la Reina de los Angeles."

Servant of God Fr. Emil Kapaun

Servant of God, Fr. Emil Kapaun, was an American military chaplain who served heroically on the battlefield as well as inside of a POW camp in North Korea until his death. While a POW, he cared for other prisoners bodily with stolen food and medicine, and spiritually as a priest.



His cause for sainthood is currently being investigated due to a number of possible miracles attributed to his intercession as well as the possibility of his dying a martyr.

Emil was born in 1916 on a farm in Pilsen, Kansas. He was ordained to the priesthood in 1940. In 1944, he decided to enter the army as part of the Chaplain Corps. He served in India and Burma during the end of WWII. In 1949, he re-enlisted and was sent to Korea to help repel North Korea's invasion of South Korea. During the Battle of Unsan, he personally saved the lives of more than 40 soldiers. He and the others were taken prisoner and marched over 80 miles to a prison camp. For his bravery and service, Fr. Kapaun was awarded a Medal of Honor.

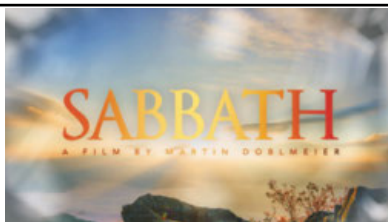
On our last Homeless Caravan, I told my partner I never thought I would be walking around town looking for people in need of food and hygiene bags. In fact, I never imagined that anyone would be needing to do this. It is desperately needed!

A few years ago, I wouldn't have felt comfortable doing this work. But today I do. What has changed in that time? Pope Francis says, "I invite all Christians to a renewed personal encounter with Jesus, or at least an openness to letting him encounter them. I ask all of you to do this unfailingly each day."

I didn't know Pope Francis said this. But that is what happened to me. For many years now, I have been reading the Gospel every morning. I read it and think about what it means to me today. It only takes a few minutes and I'll have to admit later in the day I can't always recall what the Gospel was that morning. But doing this daily has changed my life for the better.

As at Pentecost, the Holy Spirit impacts each of us according to our own abilities and meets us where we are now. I hope you who are reading this will be inspired to be open to God's calling every day and see what He has in store for you. I have faith that He only has the best things in store for me.

What is a transitional deacon?

A transitional deacon is one who functions as a deacon for a period of time prior to ordination as a priest. His diaconate assignment serves as a kind of internship of ordained ministry. Like a Permanent Deacon (usually a married man who does not intend to become a priest), they preach, baptize, witness marriages, conduct funeral services, and look after the needs of the poor.

During his year or two as a deacon, he will learn the practical aspects of parish life, getting a firsthand look at the life of a priest. His work has a different focus than a permanent deacon in that he is looking forward to ordination as a priest.

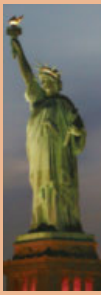

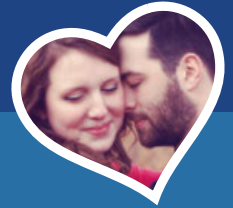
