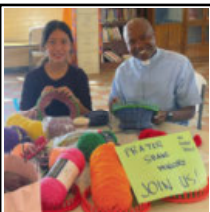
**Meditation Chant Service

**Feast of Corpus Christi
Sunday, June 11
Procession Following the 11:00AM Mass**

On Corpus Christi, the Archdiocese will begin a year of Eucharistic Revival in our parishes. The Archbishop asks that each parish host a Eucharistic procession on that day to show the beauty of our faith.

The Corpus Christi procession is a centuries-old tradition of the Catholic faith to process the Real Presence of Jesus — the Eucharist — in public. The feast of Corpus Christi was established in Liege, Belgium, in 1247. Pope Urban IV extended it to the universal Church almost two decades later, and the Corpus Christi procession followed soon after. Assumption parish will participate in this world-wide celebration of our faith by having a procession after the 11:00AM Mass.

We will process from the church east on Orange Grove Boulevard to Sierra Madre Boulevard, turn south on Sierra Madre, and re-enter the church grounds at the parking lot gate. Please join us!

The Feast of the Most Holy Trinity

The mystery of the most Holy Trinity is a basic doctrine of Faith in Christianity, understandable not with our heads but with our hearts. It teaches us that there are three distinct Persons in one God, sharing the same Divine Nature. Our mind cannot grasp this doctrine which teaches that 1+1+1 = 1 and not 3. But we believe in this Mystery because Jesus who is God taught it clearly, the Evangelists recorded it, the Fathers of the Church tried to explain it and the Councils of Nicaea and Constantinople defined it as a dogma of Christian Faith.

All prayers in the Church begin in the Name of the Holy Trinity and end glorifying the Trinity. All Sacraments are administered (we are baptized, confirmed, anointed, our sins are forgiven, and our marriage blessed, and our Bishops, priests and deacons ordained) in the name of the Holy Trinity. We bless ourselves, and the priest blesses us, in the name of the Holy Trinity.

The oldest doctrinal formulation of the Church's belief in the Trinity is found in the Apostles' Creed which has served both as the basis of instruction for catechumens and as the Baptismal confession of Faith since the second century. Later, the Nicene Creed, originating at the Council of Nicaea (AD 325), stated the doctrine more explicitly.

God has revealed to us three separate functions that are carried out by the Three Persons. He has told us that it is proper to attribute to God the Father the work of Creation, to God the Son the work of Redemption and to God the Holy Spirit the work of Sanctification. Our knowledge of God as Trinity is made possible by God, who has chosen to reveal Himself as Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

Home Visit

"The needs were overwhelming," the Home Visit team recalled, "And they were beyond what we could provide. So we just prayed." Have you heard an account like this before? The emotions were high, the needs were great, there was nothing we could do, so...we just prayed.

It's easy to feel as though we've let down our neighbor sometimes. We are, often, able to help with that overdue bill, or groceries, or rent, so when we can't it can seem as if we've fallen short. Instead of offering our alms, we share in their suffering. And we just pray.

Yet no matter the need, no matter the outcome of our Home Visit, we always pray. It isn't an afterthought! Our prayers are the most important thing we have to offer. Vincentians are people of "prayer and action." Blessed Frédéric calls us to "do all the good we can and trust to God for the rest." However great or little our efforts or our material offerings, our work is never complete without prayer.

We always pray; we never just pray. The final balance between our action and our prayer is up to God alone. As St. Vincent reminds us, "God does not consider the outcome of the good work undertaken but the charity that accompanied it."

In our prayers, we place the needs of our neighbors before God to assure them that they are not forgotten, that this, too, shall pass. We add our voices to theirs, knowing that God has placed us in their presence for this reason, that He, too, is present on our Home Visit, and that the hope we offer is not merely the hope of a light bill payment.

Pope Saint Gregory the Great taught that to give what is ours to our neighbor is charity; to give them what is theirs is justice. In this sense, at least, they are all just prayers.

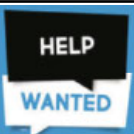
